Rationale: Climate change education can be playful and exciting

This scavenger hunt 'Climate Heroes – Find the Lost Formula' offers a playful approach to a serious topic (keyword: gamification). It contains digital and analog elements and is designed to help players develop skills such as critical thinking, empathy for nature and its creatures, and developing solutions together or communicating with each other.

The players have fun as they solve the puzzles. Depending on the options they choose, they make an active contribution to climate protection or to the protection of forest creatures, for example by planting a tree or building a Bug Hotel.

The game can be played anywhere: in the classroom, at any location in the school area, in extracurricular learning spaces, and at home in the living room or garden.

Scavenger Hunt Game Guide

A location-independent, digitalanalog scavenger hunt for children aged 9-13, focused on the topic of climate change and its effect on our forests for children aged 9-13.

What is the Assignment?

Jacob has had a huge mishap: the formula for saving the forest from climate change, which he had to take care of, has disappeared. Be Climate Heroes and help Jacob find the Lost Formula by solving tricky puzzles about the forest and more.

Game directions

- The scavenger hunts are played in pairs or teams of three.
- Each pair / team receives a mobile device (ideally a smartphone), on which the Locandy app is installed (and possibly already the game see below)
- Each pair / team will need a clipboard, a map (see overleaf) and a pen.
- The QR codes to open the individual stations are to be distributed in the room.
- Instruct the students to read the texts carefully, listen to the audios and watch the videos until the end.
